**14 events have been carried out within this project**

**Event 1 – Kick-off meeting**

**Participation:** The event involved 9 citizens, including 5 participants from the city of Constanta (**Romania**), 4 participants from the city of Cluj-Napoca (**Romania**) etc.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place online, via Skype **Short description:** The aim of the event was to establish the workflow in the project and clarify the activities in the project.

**Event 2 - Launch of local campaigns Participation:** The event involved 42 citizens, including 16 participants from the city of Constanta (**Romania**), 26 participants from the city of Cluj-Napoca (**Romania**) etc.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Tomis Pub (**Constanta, Romania**), on the 23/01/2018 **Short description:** The aim of the event was to meet local activists and local journalists and discuss what are the most important issues at the level of the city of Constanta and the perception of the use of EU funds at local level. Secondly, we presented the purpose of the project and the launching of the monitoring campaign.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Hall Room 1A at Faculty of Political Science, Administration and Communication, Babes-Bolyai University (**Cluj-Napoca, Romania**), on the 26/01/2018 **Short description:** The aim of the event was to meet and debate with students of the university what are the most important issues at local level in Cluj-Napoca and launch the project. We organized a public café around the subjects of public transport, accessibility, housing and environment protection.

**Event 3 - Seminars on EU citizenship Participation:** The event involved 138 citizens, including 79 participants from the city of Constanta (**Romania**), 59 participants from the city of Cluj-Napoca (**Romania**) etc.

**Location / Dates:** The events took place at Faculty of Political Science, Administration and Communication, Babes-Bolyai University (**Cluj-Napoca, Romania**), on the 15/04/2018, 23/04/2018 and 15/06/2018 and at the Constanta County Public Library on the 6/06/2018 (**Constanta, Romania**), at the Ibis Hotel Conference Room on 13/06/018 (**Constanta, Romania**) and the Jean Constantin Multifunctional Youth Center in Constanta on 16/05/2018 (**Constanta, Romania**). **Short description:** The aim of the events was to increase awareness on the instruments available at national and EU level that enhance active citizenship on topics relevant for citizens at local level in Constanta and Cluj-Napoca.

**Event 4 - Guided bus and boat tours**

**Participation:** The event involved 36 citizens, including 11 participants from the city of Cluj-Napoca (**Romania**), 25 participants from the city of Constanta (**Romania**) etc.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place in Constanta, Romania on 22/09/2018 and in Cluj-Napoca, Romania on 25/10/2018.

**Short description:** The aim of the boat tour in Constanta was for participants to observe the development of the coastline in the context of participative urbanism, including erosion and constructions and enlargement of the beaches. Also, the walking tour had the purpose of identifying and presenting the projects financed in the old city center and the harbor through EU funds. The aim of the tour in Cluj-Napoca was to increase awareness among participants about how EU funds have helped develop and modernize the city in terms of public transport, accessibility and urban regeneration.

#### **Event 6 - Public debates**

**Participation:** The event involved 30 citizens, including 30 participants from the city of Constanta (**Romania**),

**Location / Dates:** The event took place at Ovidius University, Faculty of Journalism (**Constanta, Romania**), on 28/11/2018 **Short description:** The aim of the event was to debate the future of EU in the context of fake news campaigns which are more and more frequent in most EU member countries. The debate included a workshop about detecting and combating fake news in the online sphere.

#### **Event 7 - Closing press conference**

**Participation:** The event involved 77 citizens.

**Location / Dates:** The event took place In Bucharest, Romania, Hotel Athene Palace Hilton on 5/12/2018 **Short description:** The aim of the event was to present the conclusions and the activity report of the project, awards the students who have been involved in the monitoring campaign and the photo competition.
